In the later part of August and into September 2012, I started having backache and my hips also ached. I thought I was having arthritis pains. I went to the chiropractor repeatedly, but it did not seem to help all that much.

Until finally my legs and hips hurt to the extent that I was using a cane to walk and next I had to use two canes. I went to a different chiropractor, his name was Sam Yoder. I asked him to take an x-ray before he does anything. When he looked at the x-rays he said he wants me to see an urologist. He wanted me to have a biopsy taken to find out what my PSA count would be. I refused to have a biopsy taken. I knew that it could be done by blood sample, which I agreed to do.

I wanted a second opinion, so I went back to the regular chiropractor and I had her take an x-ray and she was of the same opinion. She wanted to send me to Mexico the next day.

We had special anointing services Sunday evenings before we left.

Through our son-in-law, Galen, we connected with a doctor in Sarasota, Florida, that was against biopsies, surgery, chemotherapy, or radiation. After a conference call with him, we agreed to use his services. First thing he needed was a blood sample for a PSA count. We did not get a PSA report until we were in Missouri on the way to grandson Jeremy and Carmen's wedding in Arkansas. The report was an alarming number of 154.

After we came home we began to be serious about making arrangements with the doctor in Sarasota, Florida. I asked him where he is located. He started rattling off some route numbers and, lo and behold, he is located at the end of Bahia Vista Street in Pinecraft. He said there are motels close by where we could stay. But I called our good friends, Roy and Mary Miller that have a house in Pinecraft and they said their house is empty and we can stay there, which

was about a 10–15 minute drive from the doctor's office. Plans were made to meet with the doctor on Monday, October 8. We decided to leave for Florida on Wednesday, October 3, so we could be there for the weekend.

I was not able to drive and for my wife to do all the driving was asking too much, and on top of that my wife was starting with a head cold. Phillip Miller, one of our single brethren, so kindly volunteered to be our driver. He drove every mile of the way. My wife's head cold settled in her eyes. They watered so bad she could not even see to drive.

By Friday noon we were in Sarasota, Florida. Irma Bender brought us the keys to Roy's house. What a blessing! Now we had only about 10–15 minutes to the doctor.

We went and got us some groceries and settled in. On Sunday we went to the Tourist church where we met some old time friends, especially David and Susie Borntrager.

Monday morning we had our first visit with the doctor. After all the paper work I had an MRI and then an ultrasound which confirmed that I had Prostate Cancer. I was given a hormone shot that is supposed to last for three months an \$800 shot. On Thursday I had a PET scan and then we were to come back in on Monday for the final diagnosis. The report, which was not what we had hoped for, showed Bone Cancer throughout my body besides the Prostate Cancer.

On October 9, Tuesday evening, there was a planned meeting at the Essen House with a presentation on Nature's Pearl Muscadine grape seed extract which some of the Florida residents were using with good results, and we were invited. We were given two bottles of the capsules by one of our friends. I started using them right away. The next Monday evening there was another meeting put on by a doctor for the same company. This added dimension to the first presentation.

After a phone call from my good friend, Adin Troyer from Sugarcreek, Ohio, who had been to Tulsa, Oklahoma, with a similar case as mine. We adopted his special diet for myself. No bread-no sugar-no potatoes-no carrots-no red meat-no fresh fruit-no dairy products-no corn.

I can have brown rice-black beans-fresh and raw vegetables-grass fed chicken/turkey, fish and they recommended goat's milk. I do feel good on this diet.

We came home October 23. As we reflect back we see all these arrangements as by divine design.

Yes, we had to miss the Fellowship Meetings at the Crowleys Ridge, which we had looked forward to.

And again, THANK YOU ALL for your prayer support.

God only knows what the future holds for us. At the present I have very little or no pain. I feel good, but I know that something is there and I do have my limitations; however, I am working in the shop. Sometimes I almost hesitate to say how good I feel. May God be glorified. God has been so good to us and we trust Him for the future.

I have lost some weight. In fact, I am back to the same weight I had 52 years ago when we got married.

Words fail me to express my thanks to you all. We feel unworthy to be part of church family that is concerned about maintaining a New Testament Apostolic Anabaptist vision of the Church.

There was a stomach flu making its invasion on a pretty wide spectrum and not just in our community. I also was having a lot of gas and no place for it to go. I had to use enemas to relieve the gases. We did go to the local doctor several times. We were told it most likely is just the flu.

I was losing my appetite and could hardly eat. I was losing weight quite fast. In fact I ended up weighing less then I did when we got married 52 years ago.

Our local doctor got an appointment with Doctor Rodriquez in Louisville, Kentucky for March 19. After a short exam he ordered a CAT scan for us which showed a tumor on my ascending colon. I had the colonoscopy taken at the Norton Hospital. Again they found a large tumor that kept my gases trapped.

Probably one of the worst things before surgery was drinking that saline solution to clear my colon until clear water came out.

I was put on a liquid diet. I went through all kinds of tests.

The surgery went well and on April 1, I was dismissed from the hospital.

We've had a lot of visitors and phone calls. I wonder, just how could someone go through something like this without family and church support. We have so much to be thankful for. God is good.

Thank you all for your patience with me. We don't know what the future holds, but we know who holds the future.

My strength is not back to where it was, but we are thankful for all the encouragements that we get from so many good people. God Bless you all.

Brothers

The following information is largely information (with a few exceptions) that Edwin Miller from Wellman, Iowa, had used in his Family History of the Descendents of Henry B. Miller, (Edwin was kind enough to let us use his findings).

Henry B. Miller was a brother to our ancestor Adam B. Miller. So the following information is as it relates to both brothers, Adam and Henry.

Miller Family History

John (Johannes) Miller, Sr.

Great, great-grandfather of Adam B. Miller

It is commonly thought that the first Miller who was the father of our branch of Millers in this country was John Miller. Sometimes referred to as “Indian John” or “Crippled John” because he was wounded by the Indians during the “Hochstedler Massacre”. It is thought that he just lived over the hill from the Hochstedlers at the time of the massacre. At the very instant of the shot from an Indian, or from a French man’s gun as he was raising his axe to chop wood, the bullet hit his hand and shattered the knuckles of one hand as it glanced off the axe handle away from his body, which was directly in line with his chest.

According to sources, John Miller came over on the “Ship Phoenix” in 1749. With him came others with the last names of Yoder, Gnagy, Zug, Gerber, Nafziger, Mishler, Lantz, Kurtz, Mast, and Kauffman. It is thought that the Christian Miller that was on the same boat may have been John’s father. John Miller wrote his name as Johannes in German. He shortened his name as “Hannes”. He also had a son that spelled his name the same way.

Our ancestors first lived in Berks County, PA, about one hundred miles north of Lancaster in the Shartlesville area. They apparently didn’t stay in this area very long, perhaps fifteen to twenty years. From Berks County, they moved to Somerset County, PA, west of Harrisburg. A John Miller appeared on the tax list of Tulpehocken Twp. in Berks County in 1767. In 1772 is the first time that John Miller appeared on the tax lists of Brothersvalley Twp. in Somerset County. The exact farm was located by Paul Hostetler. In 1776 the farm was owned by Thomas I. Maust and is located northwest of Berlin, PA, in Brothersvalley Township in Somerset County. The farm was originally warranted to Christian Herr, and John Sr. took it over in 1785. He then transferred it to his son, Christian, in 1796, about two years before John’s death. There is a burial plot on the farm. There is one stone which reads “M.M. 1817”. John’s wife was Magdalena. It is possible that this is her stone. Virgil Miller believes that John’s wife’s name was Magdalena Lehman.

Estate Settlement

John Miller's estate settlement was recorded in 1798. His estate was appraised by Michael Troyer and Benedict Lehman. Magdalena, the widow of John, renounced her claim to be administrator in favor of her son John and Christian Speicher, a son-in-law. The two were named administrators in July 1798. Here John signs his name "Hannes Miller". Below is an inventory of John Miller's estate along with its values in pounds and shillings.

John Miller Sr.

The following are the children of John Miller, Sr., and their places of residence as far as is known:

1 Jacob Miller

b. August 1754, d. February 22, 1835, m. to **Anna Stutzman** b. April 12, 1755, d. March 27, 1814, dau. of Christian and Barbara (Hochstetler) Stutzman.

Lived first in Ellick Twp., Somerset Co., and then was one of the first settlers in the Amish settlement in Tuscarawas Co., OH. Jacob, known as “Yockle Miller”, was a minister and preached the first sermon in Holmes Co., OH, in the fall of 1810.

2 John (Hannes) Miller

b. 175?, d. June 13, 1802, m. to **Feronica Yoder** dau. of Christian and Barbara (Beiler?) Yoder of Bern Twp., Berks Co., PA.

They lived in Ellick Twp. (now Summit Twp.), Somerset Co.

3 Peter Miller

b. 1756, d. November 1, 1818, m. to **Mary Stutzman** b. 1756, d. March 13, 1838, sister of Anna, wife of Jacob Miller.

They lived on a farm southeast of Myersdale, PA, on a hill known locally as the Hunsruck.

4 Barbara Miller

m. to **Jacob Hochstetler** b. 1752, son of John and Catherine (Hertzler) Hochstetler. They lived in Ellick Twp., Somerset Co.

5 Christian Miller

b. 175_, d. after 1840. He lived in Stonycreek Twp. in the district known as “The Glades” north of Berlin, PA

6 Joseph Miller

d. before 1842, m. to **Barbara Bontrager** b. ca. 1783, dau. of John and Mary (Falb) Bontrager.

They lived in Conemaugh Twp., Somerset Co., PA. In 1842, his widow moved to Elkhart Co., IN. Joseph Miller’s first wife’s family name was Gehman.

7 A Daughter

Brothersvalley Twp., Somerset Co., m. to **John Schrag**

8 A Daughter

Conemaugh Twp., Somerset Co., m. to **Christian Mishler**

9 A Daughter

Stonycreek Twp., Somerset Co., m. to **Christian Speicher**

Stonycreek Twp., Somerset Co., m. to **Joseph Speicher**

11 Catherine Miller

Conemaugh Twp., Somerset Co., b. 1773, d. 1855, m. to **Jacob Kauffman** b. 1751, d. 1844. She was probably his second wife.

John Miller Jr.

Great-grandfather of Adam B. Miller. John Miller, Jr., lived northwest of Myersdale, PA, west of the Casselman River. The farm was later owned in 1976 by Henry Kinsinger. John died suddenly June 13, 1802, while he was handling the estate of his father. His sons, Yost and David, completed the settlement. Witnesses to the will of John Miller, Jr., were Johannes Joder and Joseph Miller. The property was appraised by Peter Miller, a brother of John, Jr. The inventory of the estate of John Miller, Jr., included:

From the will of Johannes Miller, on record, Somerset, PA, dated 1802, translated from German.

"I ask that my wife Feronica shall have her bed and the cow, two cook stoves, a Dutch pan, and dish and six spoons, and out of the value of the other saleable property, she shall have the right to live on in the house as long as she can and wishes to, and she shall have the weaving room as her possession as long as she wants it, or until she gives up her widowhood, and when she gives up the house she shall have yearly, ten bushels of wheat, ten pounds of flax, sixty pounds of meat, and her cow shall go into the pasture with the others and be fed in the stable with the rest. Besides this, the firewood shall be cut and brought into her house by whoever gets the place - further concerning the land, the mother herself, and the executors, as soon as the mother gives up the house, shall choose six men who shall appraise the value of the land, so that in time, whichever of the heirs best can and wishes to, may take over the farm. Then it shall be stipulated that beginning with the eldest until the youngest, each shall have the chance to pay for the farm without interest, until the place is paid for. I put the whole business into the hands of my trusted two sons, Yost and David Miller. I have the confidence that they will do what is right, to be executors of all my property and they shall have the right over the land, to sell it by deed, bill of sale, or other legal documents, just as they wish as though I myself were doing it. So this is my last will and testament. Sealed and submitted in our presence:

Johannes Joder Joseph Miller Johannes (X) Miller

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It is thought that John may have been infirm at the time he made the will, since he marked the document with an (X), because he had earlier signed other documents with his own hand. From 1802 to 1815, his sons, Yost and David Miller, were engaged in settling the estates of both John, Sr., and John, Jr. Some of these papers are still in existence. They were found by Oscar Miller who found them in an old wooden box on a farm in Berlin Township. They show receipts from a number of the children of John, Jr. - from his son John (son of John, Jr.) in 1808; from Ben Hochstetler, married to John's daughter, Catherine, dated 1809; and from Isaac and Emanuel Miller in 1814. In 1811, Jacob Stutzman received the inheritance for Elizabeth Miller. It appears he was acting as guardian for her as an unmarried child. It is not known how long Feronica lived after the death of her husband John. She could have died in 1811, the date Jacob Stutzman assumed guardianship of her daughter.

(Much of the above information on John Miller, Jr., was more recent information gleaned from Oscar Miller, author of the "Miller Family History" and descendents of Jost B. Miller book, published in 1976. Jost was an older brother of Grandfather Henry B. Miller and Adam B.)

Yost Miller second marriage: m. September 18, 1836 to **Marie Follmer** b. August 22, 1783. Yost moved to Holmes Co., OH, east of Walnut Creek, around 1816.

2 Daniel Miller

b. February 5, 1778, d. July 16, 1858, m. to **Magdalena Troyer** d. November 5, 1840, dau. of Michael Troyer, Jr., and Maria Reichenbach. They moved to Holmes Co., OH, around 1815 and lived in Berlin Twp.

Daniel Miller's second marriage: m. to **Magdalena (Miller) Troyer** b. July 29, 1803, widow of Michael Troyer, son of Jacob Troyer. She moved to IN after the death of her husband.

3 David Miller

b. October 2, 1779, d. 1840, m. to **Elizabeth Troyer** b. September 21, 1781, dau. of Michael Troyer, Sr., or Michael Troyer, Jr. They moved to Walnut Creek Twp., Holmes Co., OH, in 1814.

4 Catherine Miller

Sugarcreek Twp., Tuscarawas Co., OH, b. February 14, 1783, d. February 20, 1843, m. to **Benjamin Hochstetler** b. February 23, 1782, d. May 18, 1853, son of John and Frances (Mast) Hochstetler

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5 Jacob Miller

German Twp., Holmes Co., OH, b. December 14, 1784, d. 1830, m. to **Veronica Troyer** b. May 1779, d. after 1850, dau. of Michael Troyer, Sr.

6 John Miller

b. February 16, 1787, d. February 16, 1867, m. to **Anna Gnaegi** b. December 30, 1787, d. April 8, 1872, dau. of Johannes and Elizabeth (Stutzman) Gnaegi. John was 15 years old when his father died. He probably remained on the family farm with his mother until 1808, when he was married. In that year, the farm was transferred to him, as he became 21 years of age. He moved to Walnut Creek Twp., Holmes Co., OH, after 1815.

7 Elizabeth Miller

b. March 16, 1789, d. January 7, 1841, m. to **Moses Beachy** b. August 3, 1790, d. September 3, 1840, son of Peter and Sally (Blauman) Bitsche of Elklick Twp., Somerset Co. They were the first Amish couple married in Holmes Co., OH. They lived about two miles south of Walnut Creek, OH, and are buried in the Beachy family cemetery, just opposite Walnut Creek Mennonite Church Cemetery.

Minister

8 Isaac Miller

b. April 9, 1791, d. September 18, 1874. Was married three times: first to **Mary Yoder**, then to **Catherine Beachy**, and finally to **Polly Mosser**. He lived about two miles north of Walnut Creek, OH.

9 Emanuel Miller

Walnut Creek Twp., Holmes Co., OH, b. February 2, 1793, d. December 1848, m. to **Elizabeth Yoder** b. April 19, 1793, d. after 1828, dau. of Jacob and Elizabeth (Yoder) Yoder

10 Solomon Miller

b. November 10, 1795. Moved with his brothers to Ohio and was killed by a falling tree while clearing land in the early years of settlement around 1815. He was buried on the farm of his brother David on the line between Walnut Creek and German (Clark) Townships on Twp. Rd. 429. He was unmarried.

11 Elias Miller

b. June 22, 1798, d. rather young, unmarried

Yost Miller

Grandfather of Adam B. Miller. Yost was the oldest child in his family. He was born January 19, 1776, in Berks Co., PA, just prior to the outbreak of the Revolutionary War. Yost's cousin, the John J. Miller family, moved to Somerset County in 1782. It is likely Yost's family moved around the same time in spite of the unstable political situations which existed at that time.

Yost was first married to Gertraut Yoder, daughter of Christian and Barbara (Hooley) Yoder, of Stonycreek Township, just north of Brothersvalley, PA. In 1802, Yost bought a tract of land totaling 302 acres from John Keating. The land was situated along both sides of Blue Lick Creek on the Casselman River in Brothersvalley Township. His father, John, lived across the river. He lived here for about thirteen years then he transferred the property to Abraham Miller around 1815, after which he moved to Ohio.

Yost was well educated for his time. He did much business as an executor, administrator, and guardian while in Pennsylvania and Ohio. He helped settle the estates of both his father and grandfather. Yost was comfortable working with both the German and English languages.

Prior to moving to Ohio, Yost was nearly ordained as a minister by the Old Order Amish Church. According to the records, Yost received 42 votes, Hannes Gnagey 10, Benedict Miller 6, and John Hochstetler and Peter Miller each received 1 vote. Since the lot was used, Benedict Miller, a cousin of Yost, was ordained. Benedict had also planned to move to Ohio, but since the church called him to the ministry, he decided to remain in Pennsylvania. Yost would probably have had the same future had he been chosen.

Yost's property in Ohio was located in Sugarcreek Township, which was located in Tuscarawas Co., Ohio. This later became Walnut Creek Township in Holmes County, which was formed in 1825. The farm is about two miles east of Walnut Creek and was owned in 1976 by a Nelson Kauffman. In Ohio, Yost continued as a community leader. The first township meeting was held at his home on September 10, 1825, for the election of township officials for Walnut Creek Township. Yost was also appointed to the first school examiners for Holmes County on March 27, 1826.

Yost and Gertraut had a total of eleven children, but only four grew to maturity and had families. Gertraut died sometime after 1820. On September 18, 1836, Yost married Marie Follmer. Marie Follmer was married three times, each time as a second wife. Her first husband was David Hochstetler; her second was Daniel Frey; and her third was Yost.

Yost died May 12, 1846, and Marie died sometime during the same year. They are buried in a small cemetery on the home farm. Their stones are rough sandstones leaning against a tree in the cemetery, so it is not possible to tell exactly where they are buried. Their stone inscriptions are "Y 1846 M" and "M 1846 M". Gertraut was probably buried in the same cemetery; however, there is no legible marker for her. Following are the children of Yost and Gertraut Miller:

Benjamin Miller

Father of Adam B. Miller. Benjamin married Mary Mast, dau. of Daniel and Elizabeth (Hochstedler) Mast. The date of their marriage is unknown. Mary was born August 1818 in Somerset Co., PA, and was the oldest of 17 children. The Daniel Mast family lived near Mt. Hope, Ohio. Benjamin and Mary lived on his father Yost's farm. He added 100 acres to the original 160 acres settled by Yost.

Yost and his wife, Marie, lived in a small house on Benjamin's farm until their deaths. Oscar Miller has in his possession the contract, signed by Yost and Benjamin stating the terms of the agreement. The contract basically stated that Benjamin was to take care of Yost and his wife until their deaths, and it also stated the terms of payment for the farm land. Yost and Marie lived in the small house until they both died in 1846, about five years later. The agreement also made provisions for Susanna, the dwarf. She was to be allowed to live on the premises as long as she desired. Susanna died sometime in 1884. According to the written will on the following page, Susanna had her home with Adam B. Miller, our grandfather.

All of the Miller family up to this time were members of the Old Order Amish Church. It was sometime between 1850 and 1860 when a split occurred in the Amish Church in Ohio. Benjamin's two older sons, Yost and Daniel, went with the split, the Mennonite Church. According to my Uncle John H. Miller, Benjamin also went with the split, but he soon returned to the Amish Church. However, Yost and Daniel remained with the Mennonite Church. At the time of the split, there were few differences between the Amish and Mennonites. Reportedly, the only visible difference between the two groups were that the Mennonites had a church house, wore buttons on their coats, and wore outside pockets on their coats. Shortly thereafter, however, many other differences separated the two groups.

In his later years, Benjamin was partially paralyzed due to a stroke, and he needed to be in a wheelchair. He was hauled around in a hack, or a special cart built for that purpose. Solomon, his son, lived on the home place. Benjamin and his remaining children, which included Henry, lived in a small house also on the home place. Benjamin was taken care of at night by his son, Henry, who was then only a teenager. Henry was going to school at the time and reportedly studied diligently while caring for his father.

Benjamin died May 13, 1877. Both he and Mary are buried in a small cemetery on the home place. His father, Yost, and his second wife, Marie, and probably Gertraut, his first wife, are also buried in this cemetery.

Susanna—a dwarf, daughter of pioneer Yost Miller. In her later years she had her home at her nephew Adam Millers, this, her last will, gives everything she has to nephew Adam Miller. She is buried in Cemetery K-15 on the John Andy farm, just up the road from Adam Millers.

I have Susanna Miller's Bible, (it is in very poor conditions. Eleven days before she died she gave the Bible to her great nephew Benjamin A. Miller (known as Adam Benj and lived where Beachy's Nylon Harness Shop is today (Eli A. Beachy). Adam Benj had no children. His Bible ended up with the Moses A. Troyer family known as (Kelsy Mose) where I bought it at

public auction for \$7.50. How this Bible ended up at Moses Troyers I don't know. No relation that I can find.

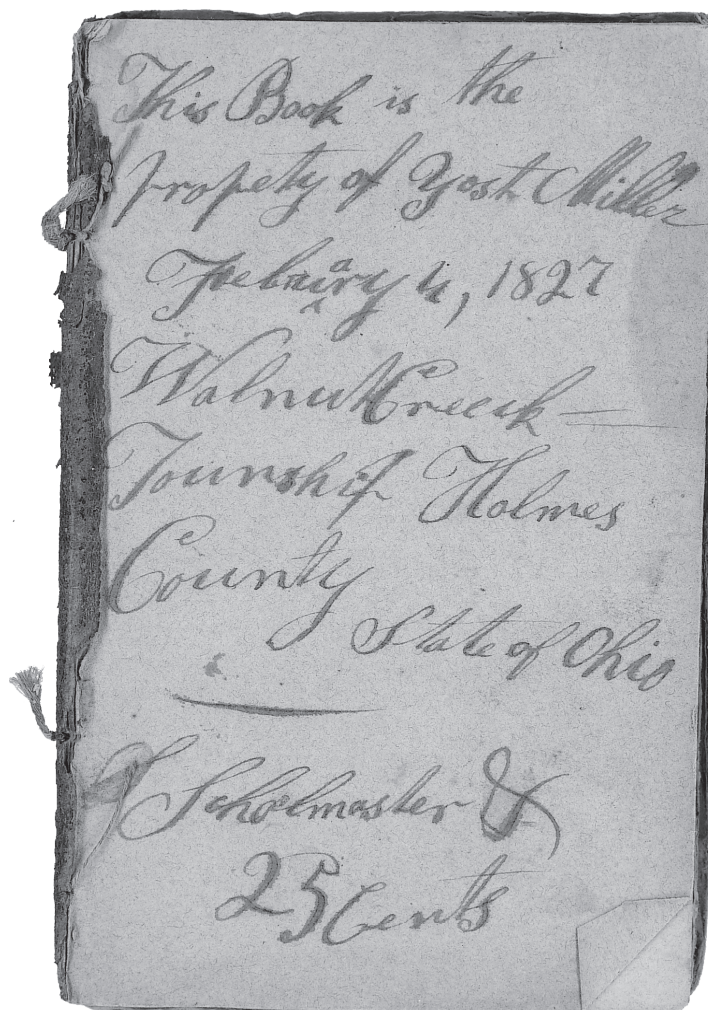
Another thought would be, maybe Mose Troyer or his wife worked for Benj Millers and that would be why they had the Bible.

Benjamin Helmuth lived where Minister Vernon Kline (Charm) lives today. Jacob and Christian Yoder were most likely neighbors or church men. It may just be Michel Jacob's two sons, one who lived where Ura's Atlee now lives, just north of the Adam Miller farm.

Henry Erb

Yost Miller—Amish Lawyer
Among the possessions of the Holmes County Historical Society is found a small 4"x8" booklet: The Pocket Companion; or Every Man His Own Lawyer. This book was printed by S. Roberts in 1822 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Its contents include the mechanics to writing legal work without the aid of an attorney, along with self-taught instructions in penmanship. How this particular book found its way to Holmes County is not sure; however, the importance this book held to its owner can be realized with his work that related to legal writings and matters. During previous times books served well to educate at home instead of seeking a higher education elsewhere. Thus, such booklets were able to help the layman in understanding legal proceedings during the frontier years of Ohio.

To identify the book's holder there is found on the inside front flyleaf: "This Book is the Property of Yost Miller—February 4, 1827—Walnut Creek Township—Holmes County—State of Ohio—Schoolmaster—25 cents." In comparing the handwriting of other Yost Miller signatures, it can be readily identified to an Amish pioneer to Holmes County—ca 1814.

Numbering System

Adam B. and Elizabeth (Beachy) Miller had 7 living children. Therefore, each one is given an ancestor number starting with the oldest:

Benjamin married Mary, but they had no descendants; their ancestor number is 1.

Mary married Jake Shetler; their ancestor number is 2.

Sarah married Elias Yoder; their ancestor number is 3.

Aaron married Mary Stutzman; their ancestor number is 4.

Catherine married Eli J. Miller; their ancestor number is 5.

Yost married Anna Miller; their ancestor number is 6.

Henry married Mattie Yoder; their ancestor number is 7.

You will notice each family numbered has the ancestor number in front of the family number, therefore by looking at the family number you will always know who the ancestor is. For example; The whole family of descendants of Mary has the number 2 as the first number as well as Sarah has number 3 and the rest as follows 4-5-6-7. The descendant number is attached to all descendants. This number indicates the amount of descendants that this number has up to this family.

Where there are "second cousin marriages", the whole family including father and mother are listed only once. For example, Raymond Hochstetler in the Jonas and Lizzie (Miller) Yoder ancestor line no. 2 married to Susie Miller from the Levi H. Miller family from the Henry A. Miller ancestor line (7). Susie's family is listed with Raymond's descendent no. 2.285, but in the Levi H. Miller ancestor, Susie has her family number on the front side of her name as follows: Susie's descendent no. is 7.208A and her ancestor no. 7.193 on the back side, this last number, tells where Susie comes from.

Most likely we have missed some second cousin marriages. Again, it was not intentional, but some of you are more familiar to us than others.

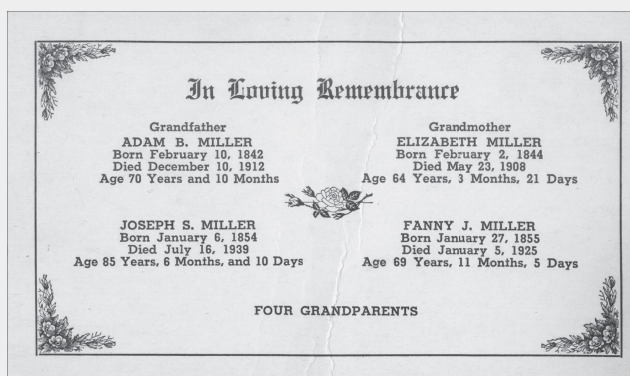

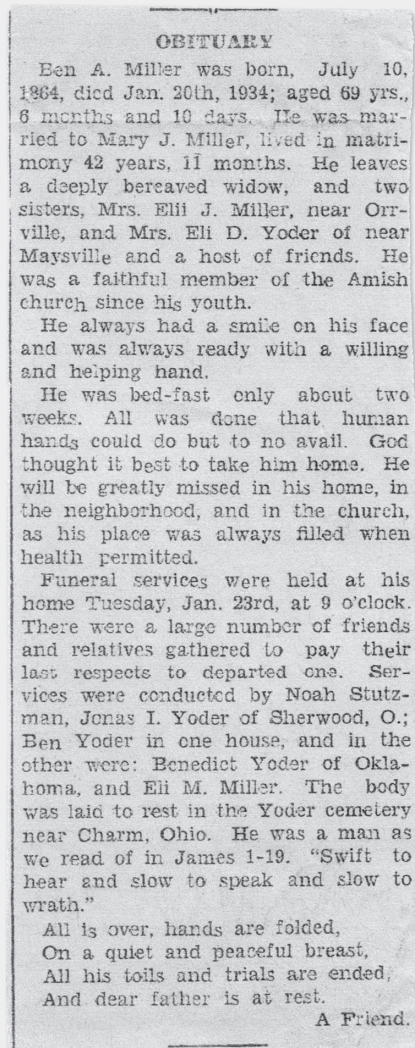

A Day to Remember

It was a dreary day on August 21, 2002. The two boys, Melvin (13) and John (11), had been stacking wood when Dad told them to get the horses in from the pasture. They were almost by the barn when it started raining. Melvin was a few feet ahead of John when going between the steel gate and barn, lightning struck, knocking him down. His boots were aflame. His pants had a large hole burned in, as well as his shirt tail. He had a pretty big hole like a deep burn in his thigh. He said at first it felt like he was floating. John said there was fire between him and Melvin. He then quickly went into the milkhouse to get water to put the fire out on Melvin's boots.

About 2 weeks later, school started and he wanted to go. We were still dressing his wound, and he was still stiff and sore and had to lie down to rest at recess. He was determined to have perfect attendance his last school year, if possible. Then the last week or so he got chicken pox so bad that he missed close to a week.
